### **CALL MEETING TO ORDER BY THE SECRETARY GENERAL**

- i. Sr Nageswaran welcomed the members and briefed on the quorum requirement which requires two times of the number of committee members to be present. The AGM met the meeting quorum with 50 members in attendance.
- ii. Sr Nageswaran informed that the handout for the meeting which consists of minutes of the previous AGM, the annual report for the term 2022/2023, the audited accounts for the year ended 2022 and the proposed amendments to the constitution were circulated together with the AGM notice for members' perusal.

### **1. WELCOME REMARK FROM THE MIPFM PRESIDENT**

- i. The 12th Annual General Meeting (AGM) was chaired by the MIPFM Deputy President, Sr Haji Ishak.
- ii. The chairman welcomed the members and called the meeting at 11.00 am.
- iii. The chairman highlighted on key matters as following: -
  - a) MIPFM has actively organised series of seminars during the term of 2022/23.
  - b) MIPFM has grown its membership to 1,000 members and to increase progressively.
  - c) The use of PMgr prefix by MIPFM members has been approved by the Malaysian Registrar of Societies (ROS) and the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia (MyIPO); the launch of it which was done just before the AGM started. The Secretariat will email to members to apply for the use of the prefix and approval is subject to meeting the criteria. Approved members shall use the prefix "PMgr" on their business card and other stationaries.
  - d) MIPFM actively engages with the IPTA (public universities) and IPTS (private universities). MIPFM has signed MOUs with TAR UMT and UTAR. Both universities offer a Degree in Real Estate and a Master's program.
  - e) MIPFM is collaborating with RICS to promote RICS membership to MIPFM members. It was suggested to RICS to open a pathway for Property Managers. Currently, RICS has a pathway for Facility Management.



- f) MIPFM has engaged in a series of meetings with CIDB. As a result, CIDB has recognised the Bachelor in Real Estate Management for CIDB code FM 01 and FM 02 registration.
  - g) Some of the MIPFM committee (Sr Haji Ishak, Prof Dr Ting and Sr Matthias) have been appointed by the BOVEAP as the Property Management Committee (PMC) and significantly contributed towards the betterment of the industry. The latest discussion in the PMC has seen positive outcome on the exam route for the new Registered Property Managers who do not have a Bachelor's in Real Estate Management.
  - h) MIPFM has proposed the Property Management Induction Course (PMIC) to the BOVEAP. The PMIC is designed for the Building Executive and Building Manager on basic and practical knowledge in Property Management; similar to the real estate negotiator course. However, since the rules are still pending, the Board decided not to proceed with this program at this moment. Therefore, MIPFM has to conduct the program on its own. MIPFM targets to conduct this program by next year and looking forward to work with COBKL as well as with the other COBs.
  - i) MIPFM has signed the MOU with Etiqa Insurance on Professional Indemnity (PI). All property management companies are required to have a minimum coverage of RM 500,000 PI coverage. The MOU is designed exclusively for MIPFM with a special package. Therefore, members shall contact the Secretariat for further enquiry on the PI insurance package by Etiqa to enjoy the offer.
  - j) MIPFM sponsors continued with the Nippon Paint Malaysia and CSS Strata Management. Recently, MIPFM participated in a retreat organised by the CSS to share ideas and areas of improvement in their software.
- iv. Sr Haji Ishak hopes members will continue to support and attend all MIPFM activities.

## **2. TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE 11<sup>TH</sup> AGM**

- i. Sr Nageswaran requested members to take a few minutes to read and review the 11<sup>th</sup> AGM minutes.
- ii. Pn. Siti Hidayah (PFM No. M1228) corrected a term on page number 5, item no. 6 (a). The correct word is 'against' instead of 'again'.
- iii. There were no further comments by members, Pn. Noor Azuana (PM 0807) proposed to accept and adopt the minutes of the previous AGM and was seconded by Mr Lim Teik Koang (PFM No. M1102).

## **3. TO RECEIVE THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE TERM 2022/2023**

- i. Sr Nageswaran presented the MIPFM report for the term 2022/2023. The following items were briefed: -
  - a) **Office Bearers for 2021/2023**  
Sr Nageswaran introduced the MIPFM committee members for the term 2021/2023. Nine (9) nos. of meetings were held during the term and all meetings achieved quorum to convene. Sr Nageswaran highlighted that the committee also had other discussions and meetings on workgroup/portfolio levels. MIPFM currently has two (2) full time staff.
  - b) **Allocation of Portfolio**  
Seven (7) portfolios have been assigned to each committee to carry out their specific duties.

**c) Financial Statement**

MIPFM accumulated funds have increased to RM 570,290.14 with a surplus of RM 98,046.22 for the year ended 2022.

**d) Membership**

MIPFM has 961 active members for the term 2022/2023 with 41 Fellow Members, 843 Ordinary Members and 77 Associate Members. 36 members are in default for three (3) consecutive years (2021, 2022 and 2023) and 390 members have not paid the membership subscription for 2023.

**e) Report on Activities: -**

**i. MIPFM Conference**

The 6th MIPFM annual conference themed 'Smart and Sustainable Property & Facility Management' was held at Pullman Hotel Bangsar, Kuala Lumpur.

**ii. CPD Seminars**

MIPFM has organised 7 seminar series to date in several key locations i.e., Petaling Jaya, Kuala Lumpur, Kuching, Penang and Johor Bahru. Sr Nageswaran highlighted that the MIPFM seminars are HRD Corp claimable.

**iii. Webinar**

MIPFM has organised 2 webinars during the term.

**iv. CDP REN Tag Renewal Program**

MIPFM has conducted three (3) CDPs during the term.

**v. MIPFM Hari Raya Open Day 2023**

MIPFM organised the Hari Raya Aidilfitri reception together with the Open Day to celebrate the joyful festival with the MIPFM members, partners and industry players.

**f) The Property Manager (TPM) e-journal**

Prof PMgr Dr Ting Kien Hwa, the Editor-in-Chief of The Property Manager, has launched the new TPM cover and Index.

**g) MIPFM Collaboration**

Active collaboration as following:

- i. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Etiqa General Insurance Berhad.

**k) MIPFM's engagement with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers, Estate Agents and Property Managers (BOVEAP)**

MIPFM were in active engagement with BOVEAP on various matters.

**l) Recognition of Degree in Real Estate Management for Facility Management Registration by The Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB)**

After a series of meetings and discussions, CIDB officially replied to MIPFM on 30th June 2023 stating that CIDB recognised the Degree in Real Estate Management for FM registration.

There being no comments, Mr Thandavarayan (Rayan) (PM0819) proposed to accept and adopt the annual report for the term 2022/2023 and seconded by Mr Wong Weng Keong @ Jerry (PM 0845).

**4. TO RECEIVE THE AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 2022**

Sr Matthias Loui, the MIPFM Treasurer General, presented the Audited report for the year ended 2022 as follows: -

- i. The accumulated fund for 2022 has increased from RM472,243.92 to RM 570,290.14.
- ii. A surplus of RM 98,046.22 was recorded for the year 2022.
- iii. Current assets for 2022 have increased from RM 493,885.94 to RM 587,572.36.
- iv. A sum of RM 560,000.00 has been placed in the fixed deposit account as to-date.
- v. Sr Matthias informed the committee is currently engaging with a few banks/financial institutions to potentially obtain higher rates for fixed deposit accounts.
- vi. The conference and CPD events are sponsored by Nippon Paint and CSS. Such income is reflected in the 'Other Income'.
- vii. The income for the TPM e-journal does not commensurate with the expenditure. The committee is hoping to get support for e-journal advertisement.

**Comments from the members: -**

- i. Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) queried about the membership income if the 36 members whom have been in default for three conservative years reflected in the audited account.
  - Sr Nageswaran answered yes, the amount reflected in the receivables.
- ii. Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) queried on the conference income, which is less than the conference expenditure. He suggested increasing the conference fees in order to make more income instead of depending on the sponsorship.
  - While agreeing with the comment, Sr Nageswaran pointed out that the institute's objective is to provide members with knowledge and learning. It is best achieved by making seminars and courses at affordable prices. However, if the sponsorship is reduced or withdrawn in time to come, MIPFM has to relook into the pricing and the membership fee.

There being no further comments, Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) proposed to accept and adopt the audited financial statements for the year ended 2022 and seconded by Datuk Paul Khong (PM 0840).

**5. TO APPOINT THE INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AUDITORS**

**a) The appointment of the Honorary Auditors (Internal Auditors)**

- i. Pn. Aniza (PFM No. M1243) was nominated by Sr Adzman Shah (PMF 0019) and seconded by Pn. Noor Azuana (PM 0807).
- ii. Mr Wong Weng Keong @ Jerry (PM 0845) was nominated by Sr Matthias Loui (PMF 0013) and seconded by En. Rozaini Nizar (PFM No. F0026).
- iii. Pn. Siti Hidayah (PFM No. M1228) proposed to close and was seconded by Mr. Ratish Kumar (PM 1007).

**b) The appointment of the External Auditor**

- i. Pn. Noor Azuana (PM 0807) proposed to maintain with the current External Auditor, Yeap Cheng Chuan & Co. and seconded by Mohd Razik (PFM No. F0028).
- ii. En. Rozaini Nizar (PFM No. F0026) proposed to close and was seconded by Sr Nor'azlan (PFM No. M1240).

There being no further deliberation, the appointment of internal and external auditors as above was approved.

**6. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION**

**a) MOTION 1: CLAUSE 2 (ADDRESS)**

- i. To change the postal address to Suite 1, Level 1, Bangunan Juruukur, No 64-66, Jalan 52/4, 46200 Petaling Jaya, Selangor
- Sr Victor Huang (PM 0592) proposed to accept the motion and seconded by Pn. Noor Azuana (PM 0807).

There being no further deliberation, motion 1 was approved.

**b) MOTION 2: CLAUSE 4 (MEMBERSHIP)**

- i. To include the Facilities Management practice in the Ordinary membership requisites
- ii. To include Asset Management in the Associate membership requisites
- iii. To create Student Membership criteria.

<b>AMENDED CLAUSE 4: MEMBERSHIP</b>
1. Membership of the Institute shall be of individuals and consist of <b>Fellow, Ordinary, Associate and Student</b> Members. Fellow and Ordinary shall be issued with a Certificate which shall remain as the property of the Institute.
2. <b>Membership shall be open to any Malaysian citizens and permanent residents.</b>
3. The membership for Ordinary Members shall be based on either of the requisites as below: -
i. Applicant is registered to practice Property and <b>Facilities Management</b> with the Governing body.
ii. Applicant has qualified with Advance Diploma or Degree in Estate Management, Property Management or <b>Facilities Management</b> from a university locally or abroad

- recognized by the Governing body with a minimum of two (2) continuous years of working experience in property or facilities management.
- iii. Applicant has more than five (5) continuous years of working experience in a managerial role in property or facilities management and it is his principal work/calling.
  4. There shall also be Associates of the Institute who will be acknowledged and issued a Letter confirming their status as Associates of the Institute.
  5. Associates of the Institute shall include those in the Property, Facilities and **Asset Management** industry carrying out various component scopes of the property and facilities management including accounting, technical and related fields. Associates shall also include fresh graduates and those with less than the required years of experience to be ordinary members of the Institute.
  6. An Associate member who is not in arrears will be automatically upgraded to an Ordinary member after 3 years of being a member of MIPFM and will be given a new membership number, MIPFM membership certificate, and will be entitled to use the initial MMIPFM.
  7. **There shall also be a Student membership. The Student shall be a person not under seventeen (17) years of age who pursuing a course leading to the award of a Diploma or Degree in Estate Management, Property Management or Facilities Management from a local university or abroad recognized by the Governing body.**
  8. Every application for Ordinary, Associate and **Student** membership shall be accompanied with the prescribed form and evidence of registration and/or qualification and/or record of experience whichever is applicable.
  9. Every applicant for Ordinary membership or Associate shall be proposed and seconded by two existing members and shall be forwarded to the Secretary General who shall at the first convenient opportunity, submit it to the Committee for approval. The committee may at its discretion reject any application without assigning any reason thereof.
  10. At the discretion of the Committee, the applicant for Ordinary membership or Associate may be called for a professional interview for clarification.
  11. Every applicant whose application has been approved as aforesaid shall, upon payment of the prescribed entrance processing fee and first annual subscription, be admitted as a **Fellow, Ordinary, Associate or Student** of The Institute and shall be entitled to all the privileges of membership.
  12. An Ordinary member who is above the age of 35 and has served the Committee and/or is recognized for serving the profession, can either apply in writing or be nominated by the Committee for the membership class of Fellow.
  13. To upgrade to the membership class of Fellow, an Ordinary member must be a member of MIPFM for a minimum of five (5) years and receive two (2) nominations from the Committee and endorsement by one (1) Fellow member.
  14. The ordinary member who is approved by the Committee for the class of Fellow shall upon payment of the relevant prescribed subscription, be upgraded to the class of Fellow and issued a Certificate indicating the status as Fellow.
  15. Applicants who are approved and accepted as members will be issued with the following prefix number:-
    - i. PFM No. F (xxxx)
    - ii. PFM No. M (xxxx)
    - iii. PFM No. A (xxxx)
    - iv. **PFM No. S (xxxx)**
  16. The designation for the various classes is distinguished by the initials after their names as follows:-
    - i. Every Fellow is entitled to use the initial FMIPFM, (which is an abbreviation for Fellow of the Malaysian Institute of Property and Facility Managers).
    - ii. Every Member is entitled to use the use the initial MMIPFM, (which is an abbreviation for Member of the Malaysian Institute of Property and Facility Managers).

- iii. Every Associate is entitled to use the initial AMIPFM, (which is an abbreviation for Associate of the Malaysian Institute of Property and Facility Managers).
  - iv. **Every Student is entitled to use the initial SMIPFM, (which is an abbreviation for Student Member of the Malaysian Institute of Property and Facility Managers).**
17. All Fellow and Ordinary members that is Registered Property Managers with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers, Estate Agents and Property Managers Malaysia (BOVAEP) are entitled to use before their names the title PMgr (which is an abbreviation for Property Manager). The MIPFM Committee shall take any such appropriate actions as may be deemed necessary against any abuse or misuse of the title of "PMgr".
18. **Subject to the PMgr SOPs and the Committee Approval.**

- Pn. Siti Hidayah (PFM No. M1228) proposed to accept the motion and seconded by Mr Thandavarayan (Rayan) (PM 0819).

There being no further deliberation, motion 2 was approved.

c) **MOTION 3: CLAUSE 6 (SOURCE OF INCOME)**

- i. To determine the Source of Income.

<b>AMENDED CLAUSE 6: SOURCE OF INCOME</b>
<b>The MIPFM sources of income are from membership subscriptions, sponsorships, contributions, royalties as well as events and activities in order to promote the objectives of The Institution. The income shall be declared and recorded accurately and clearly in the annual financial statements of The Institution.</b>

- Sr Asnul Hisyam (PM 780) proposed to accept the motion and seconded by Mr Muralithara (PM0798).

There being no further deliberation, motion 3 was approved.

d) **MOTION 4: CLAUSE 7 (GENERAL MEETING)**

- i. To revise the quorum of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) and the meeting term.

<b>AMENDED CLAUSE 7: GENERAL MEETING</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The voting members shall only be the Ordinary and Fellows of The Institute.</li> <li>2. The supreme authority of the Institute is vested in a general meeting of the members consisting of Ordinary members and Fellows. At least one-half of the voting membership of the Institute or the voting members present represent twice the total number of committee members, whichever is the lesser, must be present at a general meeting for its proceedings to be valid and to constitute a quorum.</li> <li>3. If half an hour after the time appointed for the meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting shall <b>proceed</b> to be decided by the Committee; the members present shall have the power to proceed with the business of the day but shall not have the power to alter the rules of the Institute or make any decision affecting the whole membership including those involving immovable property.</li> <li>4. An annual general meeting of the Institute shall be held as soon as possible after the close of each financial year. A date, time and place are to be decided by the Committee. The period between annual general meetings shall be called a term. The business of the annual general meeting shall be: -</li> </ol>

- a) To receive the minutes of the previous annual general meeting;
  - b) To receive the Committee's report on the working of the Institute during the previous year;
  - c) To receive the Treasurers' report and the audited accounts of the Institute for the previous year;
  - d) To elect a Committee and to appoint Honorary and external auditors for the ensuing term;
  - e) To deal with such other matters as may be put before it.
5. The Secretary General shall send to all members at least fifteen (15) days before the meeting a notice of General Meeting together with an agenda including copies of minutes and reports, together with the audited accounts of the Institute for the previous year. Copies of these documents if posted on the website are deemed to have been served and shall also be made available at the registered place of business of the Institute for the perusal of members.
  6. Service of notices shall be either by hand, by post and/or by digital medium. Thus, the General Meeting can be either physical and/or visual.
  7. An extraordinary general meeting of the Institute shall be convened:
    - a) Whenever the Committee deems it desirable; or
    - b) At the joint request in writing of not less than twice the number of committee members, stating the objects and reasons for such meeting.
  8. An extraordinary general meeting requisitioned by members shall be convened for a date within thirty days of the receipt of such requisition.
  9. Notice and agenda for an extraordinary general meeting shall be forwarded by the Secretary General to all members at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for the meeting.
  10. Paragraphs 7 (1) and 7 (2) of this rules shall apply also to an extraordinary general meeting but with the three (3) days prior to the general meeting provision that if no quorum is present after half an hour from the time appointed for a postponed extraordinary general meeting requisitioned by the members, the meeting shall be cancelled, and no extraordinary general meeting shall be requisitioned for the same purpose until after the lapse of at least six months from the date thereof.

- Pn. Noor Azuana (PM 0807) proposed to accept the motion and was seconded by Mr Thandavarayan (Rayan) (PM 0819).

There being no further deliberation, motion 4 was approved.

e) **MOTION 5: CLAUSE 9 (DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS)**

- i. To add the descriptions in the Duties of Office Bearers

<b>AMENDED CLAUSE 9: DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The President or Secretary General shall during his term of office preside at all general meetings, all meetings of the committee and shall be responsible for the proper conduct of all such meetings. Both shall have the casting vote and either one shall sign the minutes of each meeting at the time they are approved.</li> <li>2. The Deputy President shall deputize for the President during the latter's absence.</li> <li>3. The Secretary General shall conduct the business of the Association in accordance with the rules and shall carry out the instructions of the general meeting and of the Committee. He or she shall be responsible for conducting all correspondence and keeping all books, documents and paper except the accounts and financial records. He or she shall keep a record of all meetings and proceedings, attend all meetings, and record all proceedings. He or she shall keep a membership register consisting of details such as name, identity card number, date of birth, occupation, name and address of employer and residential</li> </ol>

address. He or she shall file annual returns within 60 days from the date of the annual general meeting to the Registrar of Societies.

4. The Treasurer General shall be responsible for the finances of the Institute. He or she shall keep accounts of all its financial transactions and shall be responsible for their correctness. He or she shall in conjunction with the President or the Secretary General sign all cheques and withdrawal notices on behalf of the Institute.
5. The Ordinary Committee Members shall carry out such duty as directed by the President or the Committee.
6. **The General Council shall be empowered to make donations or other benevolent purposes.**
7. **The General Council shall have the power to grant funds from time to time, as they may think fit for educational, training, collaborations or any other meeting purposes.**

**Comments from the members: -**

- i. Sr Victor Huang (PM 0592) proposed the of insertion the word 'funds' at item no. 7.
- ii. Sr Low Han Hoe (PMF 0016) queried if there is any budget or amount allocated for granting a fund.
  - Sr Nageswaran responded that no budget was set but the committee will expedite the matter carefully.
- iii. Sr Low Han Hoe suggested creating a sub-committee to be in charge of this portfolio.
- iv. Mr Thandavarayan (Rayan) (PM 0819) proposed to accept the motion and was seconded by Datuk Paul Khong (PM 0840).

There being no further deliberation, motion 5 was approved.

**f) MOTION 6: CLAUSE 19 (ENTRANCE FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS)**

- i. To add Student membership's subscription fee:

<b>AMENDED CLAUSE 19: ENTRANCE FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS</b>	
1.	The entrance processing fee and subscription payable shall be as follows: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Entrance processing fee is RM50.00</li><li>➤ Yearly subscription<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Fellow - RM100.00</li><li>ii. Ordinary - RM 75.00</li><li>iii. Associate - RM50.00</li><li>iv. <b>Student - RM 10.00</b></li></ol></li></ul>
2.	All yearly subscriptions shall be payable to the Treasurer General in advance of the first day of each year.
3.	Any member or Associate who allows subscription arrears to exceed two years subscriptions shall receive a written notification signed by or on behalf of the Secretary General, and shall be denied the privileges of membership until the defaulter settles the account.
4.	Any defaulter who allows the arrears to exceed three years of subscription shall automatically cease to be a member or associate of the Institute, and the Committee shall require the defaulter to surrender the Certificate of Membership/Letter and may direct legal action be taken against him, provided that they are satisfied that the defaulter has received due notice of the debts.
5.	Special subscriptions or levies for particular purposes may be raised from members by resolution of the general meeting of the Institute. If any member fails to pay such subscription/levies within such period as may be resolved, the amount due shall be treated in the same way as arrears of a yearly subscription.
6.	Any member or associate requesting a fresh membership certificate or letter will be required to pay a replacement fee for processing of RM50.00 and make a declaration of the missing certificate/letter.



**Comments from the members: -**

- i. Sr Low Han Hoe (PMF 0016) queried about the student's membership time period.
  - Sr Nageswaran responded that student membership would be offered for those aged 17 to 25 whom pursuing Diploma or Degree in related field and until such time they complete the studies. Secretariat will monitor and manage the membership from time to time.
- ii. Sr Nageswaran added that membership software system will be implemented soon to assist the secretariat to manage the membership effectively and prevent any abuse.
- iii. Datuk Paul Khong (PM 0840) suggested revising the membership fees as the present fees are too low.
- iv. Cheah Bee Yen (PFM No. M 1176) suggested increasing the student membership fee to RM25.00 instead considering the administrative work. A poll was taken and the majority of members agreed to maintain the student membership fee at RM10.00.

There being no further nomination neither any objection, Sr Nageswaran (PMF 0021) was elected as Secretary General for term 2023/2025.

There being no further nomination neither any objection, Sr Matthias Loui Hoong Fei (PMF 0013) was elected as Treasurer General for term 2023/2025.

**8. ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

Mr Karamgit Singh a/l Kartar Singh (PM 0885) submitted several queries as follows:

- i. Why the revenue for training state the same for audited accounts for the years 2021 and 2022 which is less than three thousand?
  - Sr Nageswaran responded that once payment has been cleared, the adjustment and reversal will be made accordingly following the timeline.
- ii. How many participants is that equivalent to for the years 2021 and 2022 and how much revenue?
  - In the year 2021, MIPFM had conduct 1 webinar & 2 seminars which collected RM 71,920. While in 2022 MIPFM conducted 4 seminars which collected RM 119,412.
- iii. How much was it charged per head? As we been paying RM300 per 5 CPD hours and the numbers don't add up.
  - Member fee is RM 300 fee and non-member fee is RM 350.
- iv. What is the revenue for the year 2023 as of August?
  - As to-date, MIPFM has organised 6 seminars as of August 2023 and has earned approx. RM 150,000 which is relatively higher compared to the year 2022.
- v. Can this fee of RM300 for members be reduced as we have more members and the fee should come down to affordable numbers. We are been paid peanuts as building managers and have to fork out RM600 per year just to comply with the BOVEAP License on top of yearly RM200 renewal fees and RM75 to MIPFM.
  - MIPFM's main objective is rewarding its' members than business/profit orientated. As such, the fee for participating in seminars, webinars, courses etc is kept affordable compared to others in the market so that more members would participate and enrich themselves. Most of the MIPFM's programmes are HRDCorp claimable. Nevertheless, the fee would be reviewed if the sponsorships get lower.
- vi. What is stopping the next AGM to be held on a day where every property manager can be available? I.e Sunday morning like it was done in year 2018? How did this AGM arrived on Thursday 14 September, who proposed it and who voted for it? and did the elected committee even put any thought to consider of members that are working on that day?
  - MIPFM had not received any complaints or grouses thus far for holding its AGM on a week day. Most employers or organisations would provide exemption or time-off to its staff whom are MIPFM's member to attend the AGM. As MIPFM is relevant to professional work and industry, convening meetings on a weekend is not feasible.

**NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - 31st December, 2023**

**1. ORGANISATION AND OBJECTIVES**

(a) General information: -

(i) The Institute is registered under the Societies Act, 1966 with the registered address at Plaza 138, Unit 7-4, Jalan Ampang, 50450, Kuala Lumpur.

(b) The Institute is a non-profit making organisation with the following main objectives:-

(i) To promote the role of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers in Malaysia as well to respect and uphold the integrity of the profession of Property Managers and its Governing body, the Board of Valuers, Appraisers & Estate Agents Malaysia.

(ii) To upkeep and promote the development of the profession of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers through active participation of the affairs of The Royal Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia (RISM) and the Persatuan Penilai, Pengurus Harta, Ejen Harta & Perunding Harta Swasta Malaysia (PEPS) and common representation in the governing body.

(iii) To provide a forum for the promotion of any cause common to the business interests of members.

(iv) To foster, maintain and preserve the integrity and status of members of The Institute, to sustain honourable practice, to discourage malpractice and to encourage actively strict observance of the Code of Ethics and the Code of Professional Conduct prescribed by the Institute.

(v) To promote, research and encourage the members of the Institute to keep abreast with latest developments relating to the practice of property management, asset management, facilities management or any of its allied subjects.

(vi) To maintain and make available to the public an up-to-date list of members of the Institute.

(vii) To acquire, sponsor, promote, organize, conduct, manage or finance or assist in the acquiring, sponsoring, promoting, organizing, conducting, managing or financing of exhibitions, trade fairs, stands or displays or other commercial ventures that are related to the objects of the Institute whether as principals or jointly in partnership with any person, company, or Institute.

(viii) To acquire and own real estate for use of the Institute in line with its objectives.

(ix) To enter into strategic partnership with third parties or to form or incorporate subsidiary companies in furtherance of the objects of the Institute.

(b) The Institute is a non-profit making organisation with the following main objectives (continued):-

- (x) To set up and maintain a panel for the appointment of arbitrators, mediators and adjudicators for the resolution of disputes that are in the areas of competence of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers to resolve as arbitrators, mediators and adjudicators.
- (xi) The income and property of the Institute shall be applied solely towards the furtherance, promotion and execution of the objectives of the Institute and no portion thereof shall be paid by way of dividend to the members, that nothing herein expressed or contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remuneration or expenses or both to any Member or Officer of the Institute or other person or persons for services actually rendered by him or her or them to the Institute.
- (xii) To promote education and training and to hold examinations to qualify members of the Institute.

**2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Institute have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standard ("MPERS") and the requirements of Societies Act, 1966 in Malaysia.

(b) Plant and equipment

(i) Measurement basis

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and any impairment losses. The plant and equipment comprises their purchase prices and any directly attributable costs in bringing the plant and equipment to working condition.

Plant and equipment retired from active use and held for disposals are stated at the lower of net book value and net realisable value. Gain and loss on disposal of plant and equipment is determined by references to its carrying amount and is taken to the income statement in the financial year in which it was disposed.

(ii) Depreciation
