MEETING AGENDA

1. WELCOMING REMARK FROM MIPFM PRESIDENT

- i. The 11th Annual General Meeting (AGM) was chaired by Sr Haji Ishak (Deputy President).
- ii. Chairman welcomed the members and call the meeting at 11.30 am.
- iii. Chairman highlighted a few industrial issues as follows: -
 - a) The rules are still pending for the Ministry of Finance (MOF) approval. Sr Haji Ishak hopes the rules will be approved soon. Therefore, the Property Managers will have a direction on the code of conduct and the scales of fees.
 - b) The Focus Group Discussion (FGD) on the proposal of the Residential Tenancy Agreement (RTA) bill by the Ministry of Housing and Local Government (KPKT). Some issues need further discussion such as the collection of the earnest deposit.
 - c) A series of meetings with the Malaysian Association of Facility Management (MAFM) concerning Facility Management (FM) practice. The Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) under their Act has regulated the FM practice under the FM01 and FM02 codes. Sr Haji Ishak said, before the CIDB regulated the FM01 and FM02, CIDB have a mutual understanding with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers, Estate Agents and Property Managers (BOVEAP). The CIDB will accept the RPM to register the FM01 and FM02 through the Greenlane. However, after a few years, the CIDB has changed the renewal requirements which has caused difficulties to our members. Consequently, MIPFM also highlighted these issues to the BOVEAP.
 - d) The proposed amendment to the Strata Management Act (SMA). Issues that have been addressed are the calculation of the shares unit formula, the single and dual rates and the establishment of the subsidiary management corporation. Some stakeholders believed the subsidiary management corporation should be allowed.
- iv. Sr Haji Ishak hopes members will continuously improve their knowledge along with the current issues and support the series of training organised by the MIPFM. Sr Haji Ishak takes the opportunity to invite MIPFM members to support the 6th MIPFM Conference that will be held on 15 November 2022. Sr Haji Ishak emphasizes the MOU signed with Etiqa is to support the members to access with a better rate given by Etiqa which is specially designed for the MIPFM. Members may contact the Secretariat to know more about the Personal Indemnity insurance offered by the Etiqa.

2. TO RECEIVE THE MINUTES OF THE 10TH AGM

- i. Sr Nageswaran briefly presented the minutes of the previous AGM that was held on 30th September 2021 which has attended by 109 members. The minutes of the 10th AGM were tabled and discussed.
- ii. Being no further comments by members, Mr Seggaran (PM 0983) proposed to accept and adopt the minutes of the previous AGM and seconded by Mr Santiraganesh (PM 0464).

3. TO RECEIVE THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE TERM 2021/2022

- i. Sr Nageswaran presented the MIPFM report for the term 2021/2022. The following items were briefed:

1) Office Bearers for 2021/2022

Pictures and the names of the Committee appointed for the term 2021/2022 were displayed. Nine (9) nos. of Committee meetings were held for the term. All meetings had a quorum with the majority of committees being present. MIPFM currently has two (2) members of staff.

2) Allocation of Portfolio

Seven (7) portfolios have been assigned to each Committee and all committees have their specific duties such as Membership & Recruitment, CPD & Training Program, Conference & Annual Dinner, Newsletter & Publication, Press / Media, Collaboration & Partnership and Professional Certification Program.

3) Membership

MIPFM has 911 active members for the term 2021/2022 with 36 Fellow Members, 798 Ordinary Members and 77 Associate Members. 20 members are in default for three (3) consecutive years (2020, 2021 and 2022) and 330 members have not paid their membership prior to 2022.

4) Report on Activities

i. Negotiators Certification Course (NCC) workshop for the Registration of Real Estate Negotiators (REN)

- MIPFM has conducted 2 NCC workshops for the Registration of REN in 2021.

- MIPFM CPD Seminar Series 2022: Property Manager Competency in Kuala Lumpur.
- MIPFM CPD Seminar Series 2022: Property Manager Competency in Penang.
- MIPFM CPD Seminar Series 2022: Property Manager Competency in Johor Bahru.

iii. Webinar

World FM Day 2022 Celebration - Digitalisation in Property and Facility Management: Best Practices and Latest Trends Webinar was jointly organised by MIPFM and ServeDeck and supported by the Malaysia PropTech Association.

5) The Property Manager (E-Journal)

MIPFM continues to provide an informative professional journal to the members. To date, The Property Manager (TPM) e-journal has published up to ten (10) editions (Vol. 4 No. 3) by Professor Sr Ts Dr Ting Kien Hwa, the Editor-in-Chief of The Property Manager.

6) MIPFM COLLABORATION AND ENGAGEMENT SINCE THE LAST ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM)

MIPFM has engaged with various organizations for the betterment of the institute and its members. MIPFM Committee had a series of meetings with the authorities, associations and organizations on the various issues in the Property and Facility Management industry.

7) MIPFM Engagement on the External Committee

MIPFM Committee has attended various Focus Group Discussions (FGD) and is actively involved in the FGD organised by the authorities, association and the university.

8) MIPFM EXCOS AS JUDGES OF THE WORLD AND NATIONAL PROPERTY AWARDS

- 2022 The Edge Malaysia Best Managed & Sustainable Property Awards by Sr Haji Ishak bin Ismail

➤ Comments from the members: -

- a) Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) congratulate the MIPFM Committee and advised the Committee to review the MOU with the CSS even though MIPFM have received the royalty from the CSS.
- b) Mr Thomas Tan also queries on the royalty indication and does MIPFM open the collaboration to other service providers or exclusively for the CSS.

- Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) answered the queries and informed the MIPFM Committee had a series of discussions with CSS to review and revise the current MOU because the MOU signed in 2012 has stated exclusively for the CSS. Both parties have discussed and we have requested to remove the exclusivity. Therefore, MIPFM is open to all service providers and allows members to have an option. Also, the royalty indication is a 5% royalty payment from the member's subscription.
 - c) Sr Francis Loh (PMF 0005) said as a former MIPFM Internal Auditor he has raised the issue of CSS royalty indication and does the CSS provide the full payment details. Sr Francis Loh suggested the Committee do a rough check on members' subscriptions and scrutinize the figures and calculations.
 - Sr David Looi (PMF 0018) answered that the CSS royalty indication is based on the 5% revenue of members subscribed to the CSS. There are statements given by the CSS to indicate the royalty amount. Sr David Looi noted Sr Francis Loh and Mr Thomas's points.
- ii. Being no further comments by members, Datuk Sr Firdaus (PMF 0012) proposed to accept and adopt the annual report for the term 2021/2022 and seconded by Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816).

4. TO RECEIVE THE AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 2021

- i. Sr Matthias Loui, the MIPFM Treasurer General presented the Audited report for the year ended 2021. The Accumulated Fund for 2021 has increased from RM411,611.84 to RM472,243.92. MIPFM's Current Assets for 2021 have increased from RM 457,035.08 to RM 493,885.94. MIPFM has a surplus of RM 60,632.08 for the year 2021 and has a Fixed Deposit amount of RM 393,885.94.
- **Comments from the members: -**
 - a) Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) queried about the CPD receivables, which he supposed should have no outstanding as participants are not allowed to be unpaid.
 - Sr Matthias Loui (PMF 0013) answered the query about the CPD receivables. This is because the seminar was conducted at the end of the year in December and the income is reflected in January in the following year.
 - Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) supported Sr Matthias's statement and add some participants are from the government sector and they used the Local Order (LO).
 - b) Sr Zaharin (PFM No. F0040) suggested the Internal Auditors signed and verified in the future audited report.
 - Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) agreed with Sr Zaharin to get the internal auditors to sign after reviewing the draft audited report.
 - c) Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816) recalled himself as a former MIPFM internal auditor, he was asked to sign after the audited report was produced. Then after the constitution was changed, the internal auditors should be signed and verified first before the external auditor produce the audited report. Mr Thomas Tan queried if that has been practiced.
 - Sr Matthias Loui (PMF 0013) said it is being practiced whereby the draft of the audited report is sent to the internal auditors first before the external auditor produced the audited report.
- ii. Being no further comments by the members, Sr Francis Loh (PMF 0005) proposed to accept and adopt the audited financial statements for the year ended 2021 and seconded by Mr Thomas Tan (PM 0816).

5. TO APPOINT THE INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AUDITORS

- i. The committee proposed to remain Sr Low Han Hoe (PMF 0016) and Sr Jasmine Liau Huoi Chin (PFM No. F0025) as the internal auditors.

- ii. Being no further comments by the members, Ms Noor Azuana (PM 0807) proposed to accept and adopt the appointment of the internal auditors and seconded by Sr Hj Mohd Khairudin (PFM No. F0023).
- iii. The committee proposed to remain with Yeap Cheng Chuan & Co. as the external auditor. Being no further comments by the members, Sr Francis Loh (PMF 0005) proposed to accept and adopt the appointment of the external auditor and seconded by Ms Noor Azuana (PM 0807).

6. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

- i. Proposed by Prof Sr Dr. Ting Kien Hwa

Motion 1: To approve the use of the Prefix “PMgr” for “Property Manager” for qualified members of MIPFM who are also Registered Property Managers with BOVAEP.

- In line with other professional bodies that have prefixes e.g. Sr, Ar, Ir, etc for its members, I would like to suggest a prefix for Members of MIPFM. Members of MIPFM refer to Ordinary Members and Fellow Members of MIPFM who are eligible to use the prefix. Members who use the prefix need to be Registered Property Managers with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers, Estate Agents, and Property Managers in Malaysia.

Resolution: To resolve as follows,

- All Fellow and Ordinary members that is Registered Property Managers with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers, Estate Agents and Property Managers Malaysia (BOVAEP) are entitled to use before their names the title PMgr (which is an abbreviation for Property Manager). The MIPFM Committee shall take any such appropriate actions as may be deemed necessary against any abuse or misuse of the title of "PMgr".

Prof Sr Dr. Ting Kien Hwa explain that the members had voted on the PMgr motion in the previous AGM. The prefix PMgr is eligible for MIPFM members who are also Registered Property Managers (RPM) with the BOVAEP. In the previous AGM, the motion was mentioned as subject to the Board's concurrence. Therefore, this motion was tabled again and removed the word 'concurrence'. Nevertheless, in the recent meeting with the Board President, the Committee cordially informed the Board President of our intention to use the PMgr.

➤ Comments from the members: -

- a) Sr Adzman Shah (PMF 0019) advised to ensure the person must not have any cases pending at the Board because the Board has received a lot of complaints again the Property Managers. Secondly, to ensure the person is not a defaulter. Therefore if the person is in default for 2 years, shall not be qualified. Sr Adzman informed that there is a lot of misuse of the title such as 'Sr'. RISM has decided to come out with an assessor for a special assessment. Sr Adzman hopes the committee and the members do not abuse the use of PMgr when it is approved and wear the title with the liability.
 - Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) thanked Sr Adzman for the advice and informed the motion is to be approved and the details and criteria will be implemented.
- b) Sr Jerry Wong (PM 0845) asked on the prefix sequence if the person already has a prefix such as Sr.
 - Prof Sr Dr. Ting Kien Hwa (PMF 0021) said he used his prefixes in alphabetical order.
 - Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) said MIPFM created this proposal because some of the MIPFM members do not carry the Sr title and this is to brand our profession.
 - Prof Sr Dr Ting Kien Hwa (PMF 0021) updated similarly with the RISM and Sr prefix, MIPFM will register the PMgr with the Intellectual Property (IP) trademark.

Being no further comments by the members, Prof Sr Dr Ting Kien Hwa (PMF 0021) proposed to accept and adopt Motion 1: To approve the use of the Prefix “PMgr” for “Property Manager” for qualified members of MIPFM who are also Registered Property Managers with BOVAEP and seconded by Sr David Looi Siew Fatt (PMF 0018). No objection from the members and unanimously agreed on Motion 1.

7. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- i. Sr Nageswaran informed that MIPFM did not receive any motion seven (7) days before the AGM. Therefore, there will be no matters to be discussed however the committee is open to any concerns raised by the members who attended today's AGM.
- **Comments from the members: -**
- a) Mr. Thomas Tan (PM 0816) proposed collecting the membership subscriptions 3 years in advance considering the low membership fee and the high number of defaulters.
- Sr Francis Loh (PMF 0005) is concerned with the suggestion because there will be a chance for the committee to use the fund at once. Therefore, Sr Francis prefers to increase the membership fee instead of collecting the subscriptions 3 years in advance.
 - Sr David Looi (PMF 0018) agreed to relook at the membership fee as the PMgr has passed and will be registered with Intellectual Property (IP), there will be additional expenses to the MIPFM.
 - Sr Haji Ishak (PMF 0017) said the committee will deliberate on the suggestions given in the next committee meeting to analyze the pro and cons.
 - Sr Nageswaran (PMF 0014) opinions the membership collection is still acceptable perhaps to introduce the late payment interest. Nevertheless, those members who wish to pay in advance are most welcome.
 - Prof Sr Dr Ting Kien Hwa (PMF 0021) congratulates the Secretariat, Ms Alin and Ms Adilah for their efforts in collecting the membership subscriptions.

8. CLOSING REMARKS

- i. Chairman informed MIPFM is planning to bring the profession to be recognised internationally. Therefore, MIPFM planning to visit Strata Community Association (SCA) in Sydney, Australia. MIPFM also planning to have International Property and Facility Managers (IPFM) day. Therefore, MIPFM hopes to bring Property and Facility Management internationally and can be recognised by other international associations. 5 REPORT ON ACTIVITIES

1. ORGANISATION AND OBJECTIVES

- (a) General information: -
- (i) The Institute is registered under the Societies Act, 1966 with the registered address at No 64-66, Jalan 52/4, Petaling Jaya 46200, Petaling Jaya, Selangor.
- (b) The Institute is a non-profit making organisation with the following main objectives:-
- (i) To promote the role of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers in Malaysia as well to respect and uphold the integrity of the profession of Property Managers and its Governing body, the Board of Valuers, Appraisers & Estate Agents Malaysia.
 - (ii) To upkeep and promote the development of the profession of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers through active participation of the affairs of The Royal Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia (RISM) and the Persatuan Penilai, Pengurus Harta, Ejen Harta & Perunding Harta Swasta Malaysia (PEPS) and common representation in the governing body.
 - (iii) To provide a forum for the promotion of any cause common to the business interests of members.
 - (iv) To foster, maintain and preserve the integrity and status of members of The Institute, to sustain honourable practice, to discourage malpractice and to encourage actively strict observance of the Code of Ethics and the Code of Professional Conduct prescribed by the Institute.
 - (v) To promote, research and encourage the members of the Institute to keep abreast with latest developments relating to the practice of property management, asset management, facilities management or any of its allied subjects.
 - (vi) To maintain and make available to the public an up-to-date list of members of the Institute.
 - (vii) To acquire, sponsor, promote, organize, conduct, manage or finance or assist in the acquiring, sponsoring, promoting, organizing, conducting, managing or financing of exhibitions, trade fairs, stands or displays or other commercial ventures that are related to the objects of the Institute whether as principals or jointly in partnership with any person, company, or Institute.
 - (viii) To acquire and own real estate for use of the Institute in line with its objectives.
 - (ix) To enter into strategic partnership with third parties or to form or incorporate subsidiary companies in furtherance of the objects of the Institute.

(b) The Institute is a non-profit making organisation with the following main objectives (continued):-

- (x) To set up and maintain a panel for the appointment of arbitrators, mediators and adjudicators for the resolution of disputes that are in the areas of competence of Property Managers, Asset Managers and Facilities Managers to resolve as arbitrators, mediators and adjudicators.
- (xi) The income and property of the Institute shall be applied solely towards the furtherance, promotion and execution of the objectives of the Institute and no portion thereof shall be paid by way of dividend to the members, that nothing herein expressed or contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remuneration or expenses or both to any Member or Officer of the Institute or other person or persons for services actually rendered by him or her or them to the Institute.
- (xii) To promote education and training and to hold examinations to qualify members of the Institute.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Institute have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standard ("MPERS") and the requirements of Societies Act, 1966 in Malaysia.

(b) Plant and equipment

(i) Measurement basis

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and any impairment losses. The plant and equipment comprises their purchase prices and any directly attributable costs in bringing the plant and equipment to working condition.

Plant and equipment retired from active use and held for disposals are stated at the lower of net book value and net realisable value. Gain and loss on disposal of plant and equipment is determined by references to its carrying amount and is taken to the income statement in the financial year in which it was disposed.

(ii) Depreciation

Plant and equipment are depreciated on a straight line basis over their estimated useful lives. The principal annual rates used are as follows:-

(c) Receivables

Receivables are stated at nominal value as reduced by the appropriate allowances for estimated irrecoverable amounts. Known bad debts are written off and allowance is made for any specific receivables considered to be doubtful of collection.

(d) Payables and Provisions

Payables are carried at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in the future for the goods and services received.

Provisions are recognised when the Institute has a present legal or constructive obligation as a result of past events, when it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, and when a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

(f) Impairment of Assets

At each balance sheet date, the Institute reviews the carrying amounts of its assets (other than inventories and deferred tax assets), to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have suffered an impairment loss. If such indication exists, impairment is measured by comparing the carrying values of the assets with their recoverable amounts. Recoverable amount is the higher of net selling price and value in use, which is measured by reference to discounted future cash flows. Recoverable amounts are estimated for individual assets or, if it is not possible, for the cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs.

An impairment loss is charged to the income statement immediately. Reversal of impairment losses recognised in prior years is recorded when there is an indication that the impairment losses recognised for the asset no longer exist or have decreased. The reversal is recognised to the extent of the carrying amount of the asset that would have been determined (net of amortisation and depreciation) had no impairment loss been recognised. The reversal is recognised in the income statement immediately.

(g) Income Recognition

Subscription income is recognised on a receipt basis.

(h) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash comprises cash in hand, at bank and demand deposits. Cash equivalents are short term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to insignificant risk of changes in value.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - 31st December, 2022**3. FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT POLICIES**

The Institute's financial risk management policy seeks to ensure that adequate financial resources are available for the development of the Institute's businesses whilst managing its risks. The Institute operates within clearly defined guidelines that are approved by the Board of Committee and the Institute's policy is not to engage in speculative transactions.

The main areas of financial risks faced by the Institute and the policy in respect of the major areas of treasury activity are set out as follows:-

(a) Credit risk

This is the risk that a counter party is unable to pay its debts or meet its obligations.

The credit risk attributed to receivables is mitigated by the application of internal credit review procedures.

(b) Liquidity and cash flow risks

Liquidity or funding risk is the risk of the inability to meet commitments associated with financial instruments while cash flow risk is the risk of uncertainty of future cash flow amount associated with a monetary financial instrument.

As part of its overall prudent liquidity management, the Institute maintains sufficient levels of cash and cash equivalents to meet its working capital requirement.

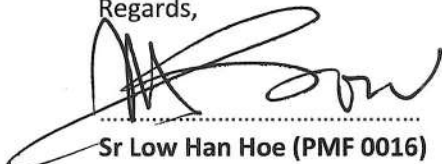
